Who should attend	Those people who work with aspects of Consultation, Return-to-work Coordinators, OHS Representatives and Managers		
Course aims	This qualification reflects the role of individuals who use well-developed skills and a broad knowledge base in a wide variety of contexts. They apply solutions to a defined range of unpredictable problems, and analyse and evaluate information from a variety of sources. They may provide leadership and guidance to others with some limited responsibility for the output of others. This qualification would suit an OHS officer in a full-time dedicated role who works under the supervision of an OHS Coordinator or OHS Manager.		
Qualification Rules	<p>Prerequisite requirements</p> <p>There are no prerequisite requirements for individual units of competency.</p> <p>6 occupational health and safety units including: BSBOHS408A Assist with compliance with OHS and other relevant laws and at least one of BSBOHS405B Contribute to the implementation of emergency procedures, or BSBOHS406B Use equipment to conduct workplace monitoring</p> <p>Plus 3 elective units</p> <p>At least 2 of the elective units must be selected from the remaining occupational health and safety units or the elective units listed. The other elective unit may be selected from the remaining occupational health and safety units, the remaining elective units, anywhere else in the BSB07 Business Services Training Package or any other currently endorsed national Training Package, of which 1 unit may be selected from a Certificate III or Diploma qualification. Elective units must be relevant to the work outcome, local industry requirements and the qualification level.</p> <p>Pathways into the qualification</p> <p>Candidates may enter the qualification through a number of entry points demonstrating potential to undertake vocational education and training at certificate level, including</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • after achieving the BSB30707 Certificate III in Occupational Health and Safety or other relevant Certificate III qualification, OR • providing evidence of competency in the majority of units required for the BSB30707 Certificate III in Occupational Health and Safety, OR • with extensive vocational experience in occupational health and safety roles. <p>Pathways from the qualification</p> <p>After achieving the BSB41407 Certificate IV in Occupational Health and Safety, candidates may undertake the BSB51307 Diploma of Occupational Health and Safety, a qualification for those wishing to develop specialised skills and knowledge required to coordinate and maintain the OHS program within an organisation, or a range of other Diploma level qualifications.</p>
