Who should attend	Persons working in the areas of Arboriculture, Agriculture & Horticulture where from time to time they are required to fell small trees		
Pre requisite	Attendance or completion of the entry level course Operate & Maintain Chainsaws		
Venue:	Note a suitable venue must be provided by the booker, this requires 6 trees available for felling per student. Trees must be 300mm thick at a height of 900mm from the ground.		
Course aims	To train staff who operate chainsaws in the correct & effective operation ensuring awareness of safety & basic maintenance issues.		
Learning outcomes	The course covers the competency requirements for RTC2005A. The course requires the felling of small trees in an environment where there are only low risk hazards. It covers the assessment of conditions & surroundings in the area where the tree is to be felled. The course covers also the clean up of the area & following of safe working procedures. The felling is performed under strict supervision. The course also covers aspects & theory regarding team felling. Competency will be demonstrated during the course & some theoretical work.
