Who should attend	This unit describes a fundamental workplace OHS risk management skill for those working in the service industries & applies to the full range of industry sectors & environments.		
Course aims	This unit describes the performance outcomes, skills & knowledge required to identify hazards, assess the associated safety risks & take measures to eliminate or control & minimise the risk. It focuses on the processes necessary to control specific workplace safety risks. This risk management approach is central to compliance with OHS legislation, which imposes obligations on businesses in all Australian States & Territories (whether small, medium or large) to manage the safety of their workers & anyone else in the workplace. In the service industries, the workplace would include any location where the business operates & 'others' would include customers. No occupational licensing or certification requirements apply to this unit at the time of endorsement.
