Select eight elective units from any section of the Local Government Training Package or from any other endorsed Training Package, while ensuring the integrity of the AQF level. Eight of the elective units may be imported. No more than one elective unit may be drawn from an AQF level below or above the AQF level of this qualification.</p> | | |
