<b>Duration</b>	12 month nominal	<b>Traineeship</b>	New Entrant
<b>Who should attend</b>	This course is for people who want to develop the skills and knowledge needed to work at the entry-level or under limited supervision as a skilled operator or tradesperson in the horticulture industry.		
<b>Course aims</b>	<p>You will complete a range of general horticulture modules and may choose electives from a range of industry specific modules. The course delivers nationally recognised credentials, helping graduates gain workplace training to get all the hands-on experience they need. You'll learn a mix of horticultural and retail skills – identifying plants and soil types, potting and pruning, basic tree surgery and customer service and communication.</p> <p><b>Career Opportunities:</b> General horticulturist, arborist, floriculturist, landscaper, nursery person, gardener, greenkeeper.</p>		
<b>Qualification Rules</b>	<p>For a Certificate II in Horticulture at least 13 units of competence must relate to the general horticultural procedures, activities or contexts. In addition, at least 13 of the units selected to make up this qualification must be clearly aligned to the Certificate II outcomes.</p> <p>A total of <b>17 units</b> of competency must be completed</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Complete the 4 designated compulsory units from Group A</li> <li>- then, Select 10 additional units from Group B and/or C</li> <li>- Units should be selected from Group B in accordance with local work undertaken and local industry advice</li> </ul> <p><b>Group C</b> This group includes other units of competency from RTD02 Conservation and Land Management, RTE03 Rural Production, RTF03 Amenity Horticulture and/or other endorsed Training Packages. Units selected must be aligned to Certificate I,II or III outcomes. These units must be relevant to work undertaken in the horticulture sector.</p>
