Pre-requisites	Adequate literacy- It is a pre-requisite that candidates hold Work Cover NSW OH&S Construction Induction certificate or equivalent. All traffic controllers in NSW working on RTA roads & road related sites will be required to hold or have held a minimum of a Provisional "P2" Driver's Licence from 1 November 2006 or a current Traffic Controllers Ticket or a NSW Traffic Controller card that has expired within the past two years.		
Course aims	This course provides training for staff who are required to control traffic with a stop/slow bat. This course will provide participants with the knowledge, skills & attributes to perform traffic control safely for their co-workers & the public.
